


Welcome to Milton Hershey School


One Mission

Residential Roles

Houseparents

This critical role at MHS is held by married couples who live on campus full time with a group of students over several years. Houseparents care for their students before and after school, teaching them skills and values outside of the classroom to help them succeed. A houseparent's role is to be there as each child grows up, be someone they can trust, and help them become the best versions of themselves.

Houseparents are provided everything they need to have the greatest possible impact on the students in their care, including a fully furnished house, food, supplies, and more. Houseparent couples work collaboratively with other staff to invest in students' lives and build relationships with students' families to help each child reach their full potential. The houseparent community is made up of over 200 houseparent couples who can lean on, learn from, and spend time with each other as they work through similar challenges and realities. Shaping the lives of students is not easy, but it's a career in which students' and houseparents' lives are positively impacted.





Transitional Living Assistants

MHS hires individuals as part of our residential staff to oversee our Transitional Living (TL) program. In their senior year of high school, students live in apartment-style housing to develop independent living skills. The TL program exists to teach students the life skills necessary to survive and thrive as self-sufficient adults. This support aids students as they bridge the final gap between childhood and adulthood.

Transitional Living Assistants (TLAs) live in on-campus housing and provide teaching, advising, mentoring, and supervision to students as they prepare for graduation. TLAs serve as role models and mentors. This is a pivotal role as TL staff collaborate to ensure each graduating senior is well prepared for post-graduation success.

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Scholastic & Instruction

At MHS, we are committed to providing every child the best teachers, facilities, and academics—regardless of their family's income. MHS teachers go above and beyond what's expected of them as they develop the next generation of leaders. From delivering a top-notch education inside and outside of the classroom to mentoring students in their free time, teachers at MHS are more than just educators—they're difference makers. Our education experts are able to focus their attention on building stronger student relationships due to well-resourced classrooms, exceptional professional development support, and a low student-to-faculty ratio—eliminating stressors found elsewhere in education.



Career and Technical Education & Extracurricular Instructors

MHS also hires industry experts to bring their knowledge and resources to our classrooms. Career and Technical Education instructors develop curriculum and experiential learning in response to workforce trends to position students for success. Coaches and specialty instructors lead students in many extracurricular and summer activities. Areas of focus include agriculture, athletics, driving, performing arts, visual arts, summer programming, and many other recreational areas.

It Takes a Village

It takes a village of mission-driven professionals to keep our campus of more than 2,000 students operating smoothly. By attracting and retaining the best, most talented people and deepening their sense of purpose, we continue to strengthen our community ties and keep bonds that make MHS welcoming and unique. Staff set an example of perseverance, excellence, and a strong work ethic for the children we serve and become role models through mentor programs at every age level.

Health Care Professionals

As a home and school, Milton Hershey School provides comprehensive care for our students, including medical, dental, and psychological services. MHS staffs medical clinics in each school (elementary, middle, and high school buildings) and maintains a 40-bed health center with an infirmary. Additionally, there are dental clinics and psychological services offices in each school. A licensed social worker coordinates student health services and connects them to everything available.

We collaborate with Penn State Health Milton S. Hershey Medical Center and other health care providers for complex student medical needs. That means we employ nurses, certified nursing assistants, office support personnel, drivers, dentists, hygienists, dental assistants, psychologists, behavioral support specialists, and interns. Both full-time and part-time staff contribute to providing health and wellness care for our students with all costs covered.



Administrative & Operations Careers

We hire professionals for roles in finance, human resources, legal, communications, information technology, and more.

MHS also employs:
